3 PhD in Applied Linguistics Program

1. Introduction

Our Ph.D. program in Applied Linguistics focuses on cultivating experts in language education, assessment, and linguistic data analysis by integrating cutting-edge information technology (IT) into research and practice. The program offers in-depth training in AI-driven language education and assessment, computational and corpus linguistic analysis of spoken and written language, and the development of curricula and digital learning materials. Students also gain expertise in analyzing vocabulary, grammar, and content difficulty, as well as comparing learner proficiency with content difficulty to design personalized language learning programs. Through this comprehensive approach, the program systematically fosters essential research and practical competencies for language education in the digital era.

2. Program Objectives

This Ph.D. program is designed to equip scholars with the expertise needed for advanced research and practice in language education. It emphasizes key areas such as language instruction, assessment, curriculum design, and digital learning content development. With a strong focus on integrating emerging digital technologies, the program enables students to explore innovative research methodologies and develop a well-rounded foundation in both theoretical and applied aspects of the field.

Key areas of focus include:

- Advancing research proficiency in applied linguistics
- Enhancing computational and corpus-based analysis of spoken and written language
- Gaining expertise in AI-driven language assessment theories and applications
- Developing psychometric skills for language test design and evaluation
- Acquiring statistical techniques for analyzing spoken and written text data
- Strengthening programming capabilities for linguistic data analysis and research automation

This approach ensures that graduates are well-prepared to contribute to the evolving landscape of language education and assessment.

3. Requirements for Receiving the PhD Degree

- Enrollment for 6 semesters
- Completion of required courses and 36 credits
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Successful defense of the doctoral dissertation



4 Eligibility Requirements for International Student Admission

1. Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must meet one of the following criteria:

- ① Foreign nationals with both parents being foreign nationals
- ② Applicants who have completed the entire regular education curriculum corresponding to elementary, middle, high school, and university education abroad

2. Eligibility Requirements by Degree

MA	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Individuals who have obtained a bachelor's degree from a domestic or foreign university, or those who are expected to graduate by August 2025▪ Individuals whose educational background is recognized as equivalent to or higher than a bachelor's degree under relevant laws and regulations
PhD	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Individuals who have obtained a master's degree from a domestic or foreign university, or those who are expected to graduate by August 2025▪ Individuals whose educational background is recognized as equivalent to or higher than a master's degree under relevant laws and regulations

※ If an applicant fails to graduate by the expected graduation date, admission will be revoked.

3. Language Proficiency Requirement for English Track

Applicants must meet at least one of the following language proficiency qualifications:

- ① TOEFL 530 (CBT 197, iBT 71)
- ② IELTS 6.0
- ③ CEFR B2
- ④ TEPS 600 (New TEPS 327)
- ⑤ Applicants from countries where English is an official language must submit a certificate confirming that their university courses were conducted in English.



5 Application Process

1. Online Application and Document Submission

- ① Visit the online application website (<http://www.igse.ac.kr>)
- ② Select the desired degree program and major
- ③ Upload the required documents as files
- ④ The admission office will contact you and arrange online interview(Zoom)

2. Important Notes

- ① The name of the program you are applying for must be clearly stated on the application and study plan.
- ② The photo should be taken within the last 3 months and uploaded as a scanned jpg file.
- ③ The "Experience and Special Skills" section should include up to 5 entries, listed in order from the most recent, with detailed and accurate information.

3. Document Submission

- ① Both online application and document submission must be completed for the application to be considered complete.
